- Label the muscles

- Word parts and abbreviations
 - Do not forget any word part from chapters 1-2 could be on the chapter 3 test
 - You will have “pick the correct spelling” of word parts made into an actual word that you will have to identify according to rules for combining word parts
 - ***Abbreviations: look in your book at the abbreviation definition THEN look in the book for the actual definition in conditions/diseases/treatments and WRITE those in your journal
